## NOTE TO EDITORS:

Humans have increased average global surface temperatures by over 1°C since the Industrial Revolution. The international community has agreed to limit warming to no more than 2°C as this risks increasing impacts beyond the capacities of millions of people to endure. It also aspires to keep warming within 1.5°C as even this lower level would lead some nations largely underwater. At current rates of emissions, there are less than 12 years left of burning coal, oil, and gas before the 1.5°C carbon budget will be exceeded. All internationally-agreed strategies to avoid 1.5°C and 2°C warming scenarios involve highly speculative "Negative Emissions Technologies" that will need to remove billions o tons of carbon from the Earth's atmosphere and store it underground for centuries. If these technologies do not work, then even faster rates of warming may be locked in.
